Changes being proposed are designed to help resolve cases much more quickly, reducing cost, delay and stress for all involved, while also improving public protection, consistency and providing a deterrent to reduce future risk of repeated behaviour.

- Increasing the maximum fine we can issue to traditional law firms to £25,000
- Taking into account the turnover or income of firms and individuals when setting fines
- Introducing a schedule of 'fixed penalties' to enable lesser issues to be dealt with more easily for all concerned
- The consultation also looks at whether we need a more robust approach to penalising serious misconduct within the wider legal sector, for example by introducing automatic suspensions for certain types of behaviour.
